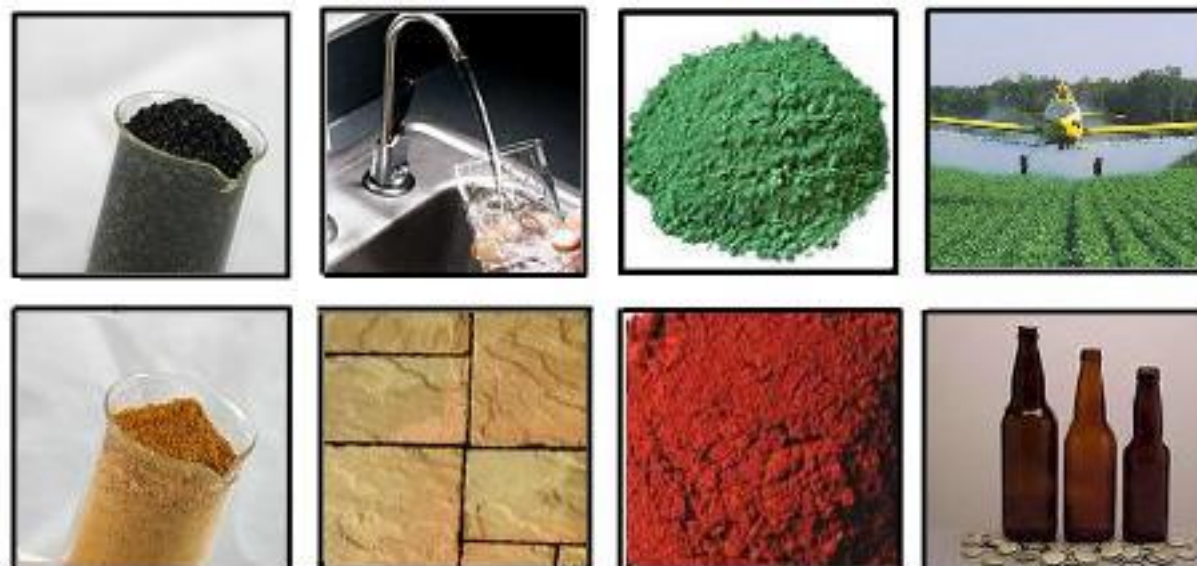




Welcome to African Pegmatite

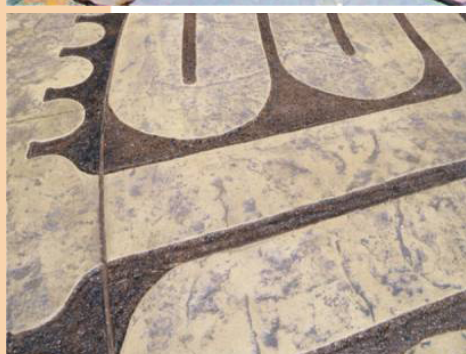
Agricultural Fungicides
